First Communication

First Report Card

The first report card will be on Mozaik the week of **November 14, 2022**. The report card will cover the period from August 31, 2022 to November 4, 2022 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Second Report Card

The second report card will be on Mozaik during the week of **February 20, 2023**. The report card will cover the period from November 7, 2022 to February 10, 2023 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Third Report Card

The third report card will be on Mozaik by **June 23, 2023**. It will cover the period from February 13, 2023 to June 22, 2023 and will count for 60% of the student's final mark. The final marks for all subjects will be indicated on this report card.
